The mercury is definitely dropping and our volunteers have been hard at work knitting blankets for the babies who need some extra warmth this winter.

We're already half way through the year and have donated 1700 care packages so far in 2022! Last month was extra special with Mother's Day, and we helped make it a little bit more memorable for 170 mothers who had the unenviable situation of spending the day in the hospital with their child. The messages we received from those who received one brought tears to our eyes.

With Covid restrictions easing we also were able to run our first fundraising event of the year. We hosted a night of connection and upskilling with a First Aid course for parents at Winnie Bagoes City. It was such a fantastic night and we raised more than \$2600! Scroll down to see pics!

Last year we were asked by one of the charge nurses if we could start supplying warm blankets because they noticed that some of the young children they were treating needed some extra warmth at home. We wracked our brains to try find a blanket supplier and then an email popped in our inbox from Karen asking if we needed knitters!!! We said "yes!" and they've been knitting ever since.
