Tēnā koe e hoa – Welcome to our April newsletter.

As I reflect on the past year, it seems surreal to think that 12 months ago I was in hospital with my youngest child Annabelle who had health concerns for her first few months of life. She's now a happy bubbly delightful 1 year old who charms our family (see below) and it's amazing to think how far she has come. It's also amazing to think how far One Mother to Another has come since then as out of that experience One Mother to Another has expanded into more wards and is now supporting more families than ever before. A definite silver lining to that cloud.

We have already delivered **1078 packs** in 2022 and the feedback from the hospitals is that they have been needed more than ever.

As Covid has ripped through the community, it's meant some families have had to be separated from their babies in hospital. We can't even imagine how difficult it must be when your sick newborn is in hospital but you're unable to cuddle and visit them until you've recovered from the virus at home. It makes an already stressful time so much more heartbreaking. For other mothers and carers who have been able to be at their child's bedside, the Covid precautions have meant tight visitor restrictions so families have been unable to easily support each other. We know our care packages don't resolve this but they do help and have been welcomed more than ever when the loneliness and stress have been at an all time high. We count it a true privilege to have been able to come alongside so many families during these unprecedented times.



With the growing need for One Mother to Another's services, we've welcomed two new amazing members to our team. Natalie and Catherine both know how difficult it is to have a child in hospital and are hugely passionate about seeing One Mother to Another flourish. I'm so excited to welcome them, their ideas and their energy on board.

And finally, a wee public service announcement ... Don't forget Mother's Day is coming up. Spare a thought for the mothers who will be in hospital that day! We're making some extra special care packages for them (you can help us by donating one if you'd like) or if you haven't yet got a gift for the special mother figure in your life - we have you sorted (scroll down).

This is where I choke up, the kindness of you wonderful humans at a time when I was so vulnerable is a moment in time I will never forget. I cannot put into words how grateful I am for your beautiful package, what an impact it had on me and how I will remember your beautiful thoughtfulness forever

It makes me well up typing this – was a very tender moment that sometimes when you're caught up in the thick of it all – that message may not get back to you beautiful people. So thank you, from the bottom of my heart, and from all those Mumma's that haven't had a chance to say thank you too.

Meet mother of two and administration support, Catherine.




